What is Rightmove Intel?

Rightmove Intel is a tool designed to help you understand more about your local market and promote your success. It's all about supporting you in getting invited out to more valuations and winning more instructions.

Market share reports

The market share reports in Rightmove Intel have replaced our older Agent Competitor Analysis (ACA) reports in Rightmove Plus . The new reports are more flexible and allow you to see competitive rankings for a greater range of criteria than the ACA reports.

Why did we replace the ACA?

We conducted extensive research with agents up and down the UK to find out how we could improve our suite of reports. The result was Rightmove Intel.

Intel allows us to address the things that agents asked for most:

- More flexibility with date ranges and exportability
- More market share metrics
- Information on a per property level



How to access the market share reports in Rightmove Intel

1. Simply log into Rightmove Plus
2. Within either the sales or lettings tab you will see a banner that looks like the example below
3. Click anywhere on the top banner to go to the Rightmove Intel dashboard



Welcome to your dashboard

This is designed to give you a snapshot of your market place, displaying the three most popular market share metrics.

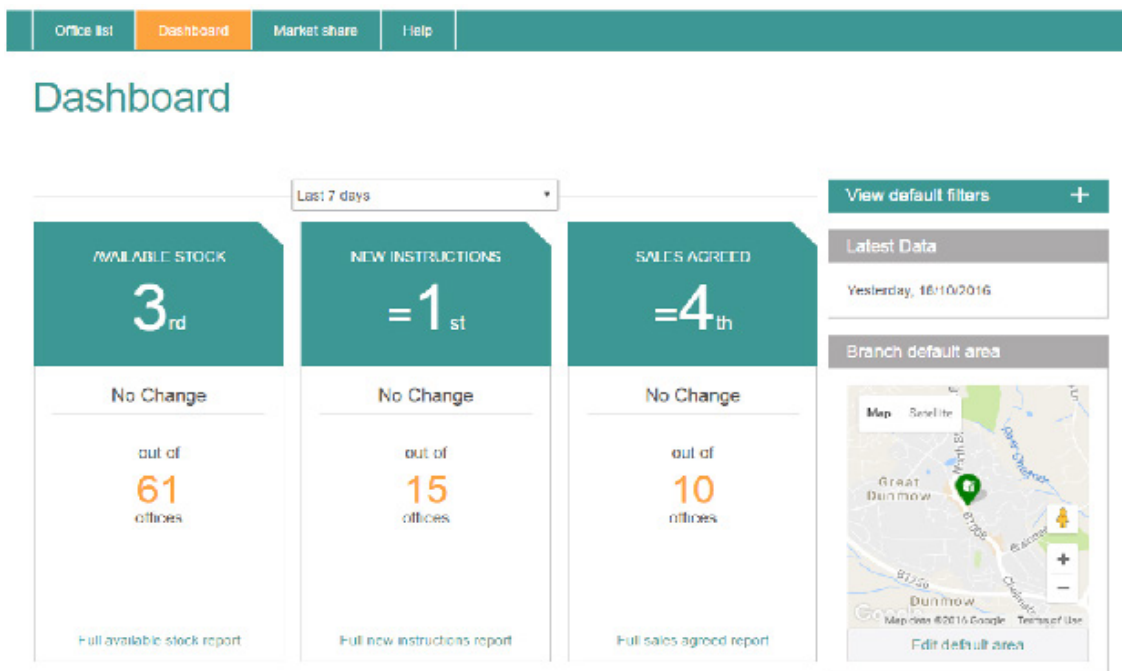
Sales: Available stock, New instructions & Sales agreed

Lettings: Available stock, New instructions & Let agreed

You'll see your current position, how that's changed and the number of agents that you're competing against in your patch. The data defaults to the last seven days.

You can change the date range using the drop down menu above the reports. Additional date ranges are available in the full report.

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Setting dashboard filters

Alter the data reflected in the dashboard reports by using the **View default filters** drop down:

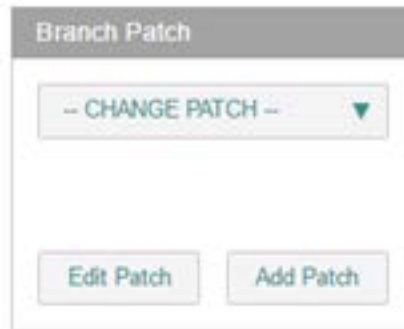
Once you have applied your filters, click on the Save button.

These settings will be applied to all of your reports within Rightmove Intel.

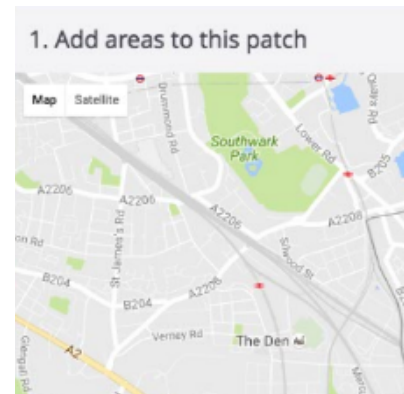
How to change your patch

Your rankings are based on your default map. This was previously set within Rightmove Plus and can now be edited from the Intel dashboard. Follow these simple steps to edit it.

1. Click on Edit Patch on the right of your dashboard.



2. Adjust your area by selecting postcode areas or using the map.



3. Then give your patch a name and choose whether to make the new patch your default. At least one patch you create must be made the default, which the reports are then based on. Finally, click Save.



Switch between sales and lettings data

If your branch does both sales and lettings, you'll be able to choose between both. Simply use the tabs in the top right hand corner of the screen. These tabs are visible throughout Intel.

This option won't show if you do only sales or lettings.

How to change office

If you have multiple offices assigned to your user profile, you will have the option to view other offices within your network.

1. Click on **Office list** in the top tool bar (visible whenever you're in Intel).

2. Choose the office that you'd like to view.

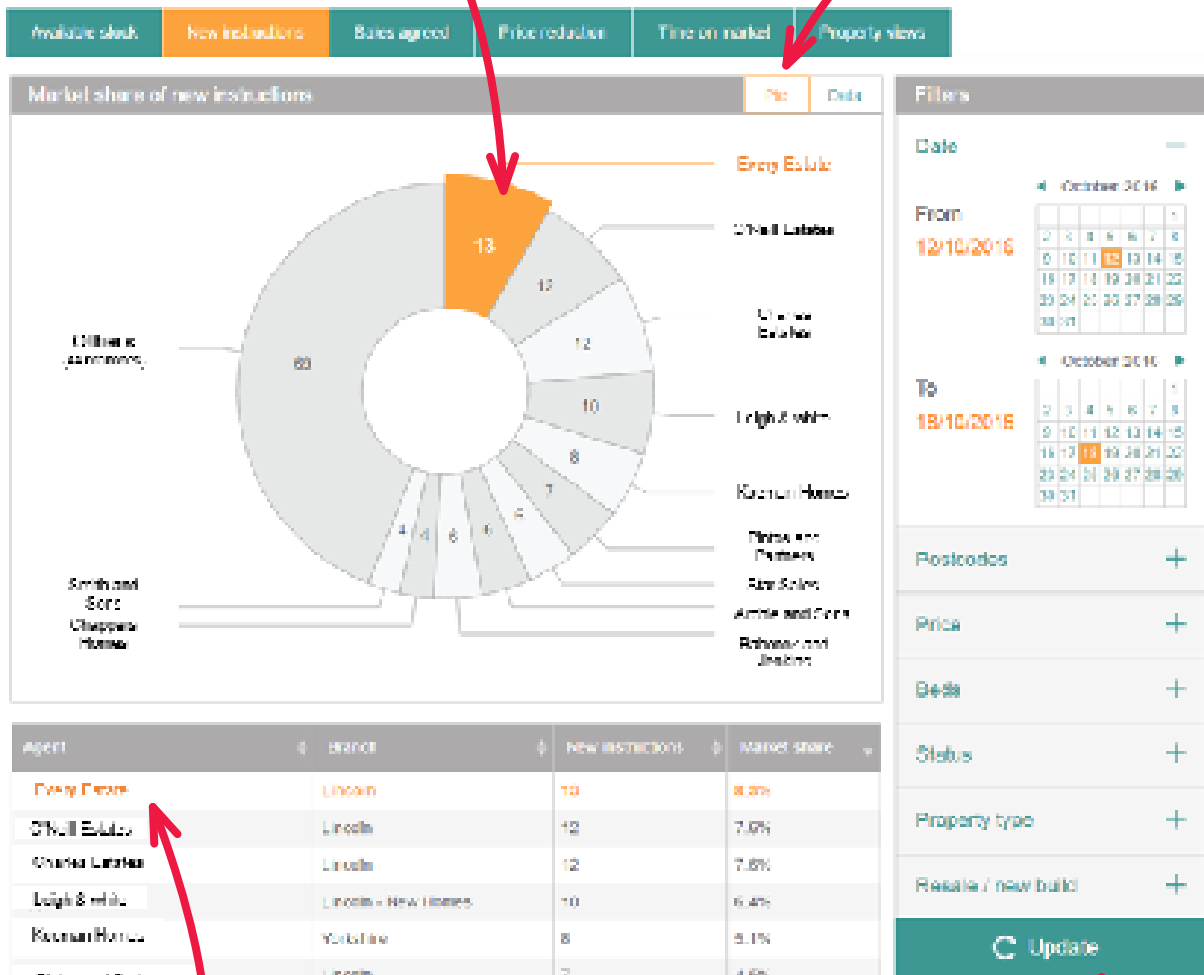
3. On the home page of Rightmove Plus, click on the Intel banner and you will be taken back into Rightmove Intel for that new branch.

Getting the full report

Clicking on any of the tabs under Market share will take you to the full report for that criteria. It'll look like this below. In this example, we've chosen New Instructions.

The six market share reports

Here's a list of all the reports you can use in Rightmove Intel when viewing your market share.

Available stock

Shows all properties that had the status of 'available' during the time period selected.

New instructions

Displays all new properties uploaded to Rightmove during the time period selected. This includes properties which were uploaded as 'Under offer' or 'STC'.

Sales/let agreed

Displays all properties that went from the status of available to 'Under offer' or 'STC/Let agreed' during the time period selected. Properties that have had multiple status changes are only counted once in this report.

Price reduction (sales only)

See all properties that have been reduced in price during the time period selected. The report is based on the number of properties that have been reduced as opposed to reporting on each individual price reduction.

Time on market (sales only)

Displays all properties that were defined as a slow mover at some point during the reporting period. This, by default includes properties which have been either available or Under offer or STC, unless these have been filtered out. A slow mover is defined as a property that has been on Rightmove for 12 weeks or longer.

NEW Property views


Shows the average amount of views of their Rightmove property listings each agent has received on average over the time period. This allows you to see how effective your listings on Rightmove are compared to your local competition.



Looking through local data

Once you have clicked on the **Data** tab, you are presented with the full data set of all of the properties which make up the pie chart.

You can add **house number/name** and **customer name** to the data sets. Any data that you save here cannot be seen by any other branch.

Simply click on the **add** link or the **edit** link (if you have previously added a note), enter the details and then save.

This data is fully exportable by using the **email data export** button. Just insert your email address into the field provided and the data will be sent through to you shortly.

Why are the areas displayed in Rightmove Intel different to what I used to see in the ACA?

The ACA was based on drawn areas or by postcode. Intel is based on postcode sectors (e.g. W1D 3), either entered manually or by choosing postcode sectors from the map.

How often are the market share reports updated in Rightmove Intel?

They are updated every day.

How far back do the market share reports go?

The dashboard is based on the previous seven days worth of data. The full reports go back historically up to 14 months.
